The website layout/logic departs from the idea of 'blowing up' Jakub's boxes (which represent how stigma isolates and attempts to hide what is considered deviant in relation to the normative moral codes) through a swarming process (remember the video of the dragon disintegrating and forming the swarm with its pieces).

So the website continues referring to the exhibition in a different (MACRO) level.

_How are we going to do this?

- 1) Swarming the pieces, we have:
- a. an open box, which results in six different surfaces;
- b. Brad's 'logo-poem' with six words;
- c. six symbols that code for something (more explanation later). They will be the first 'genes' that

will make up the swarm.

- d. Six artists/projects/works to start
- e. EC method to conceive of the swarm






ABOUT THE SYMBOLS

Each symbol occupies a side of the box and is made up with this square surface, that is, the symbols are sort of 'cut out' from one side of the box. This is symbolically how we blow up the stigma box. It also means that they all share the same origins and can be transformed /morphed into each other.


I departed from a tangram square, but it can be made without these specific proportions, but making all of them with the same parts would reinforces the concept that they are all the same thing.
